

Making nets

Following a series of maths lesson, where the children converted and adjusted a cupcake recipe, a challenge was set to draw a net and make a box to hold one cupcake.



The children were given a choice of nets and then asked to practise on a piece of A3 paper.



Once they were happy with their design and had made any modifications needed, they transferred the net to coloured card, decorated it and made it into a box.



They make cupcakes in small groups.



They were only allowed the cake IF it fitted into their box.



On evaluation, a lot of the children said in future they would modify the lid of the box so that it closed more securely.
