



## 2019 Key Stage 2 Assessment

We were very pleased with our Key Stage 2 results. This cohort of 27 children included 3 children from our Strategic Facility for children with Autism and 1 child with an EHCP. This needs to be taken into account when comparing our School's results with National Average.

The Value Added ie the progress made by this cohort of children was excellent.
